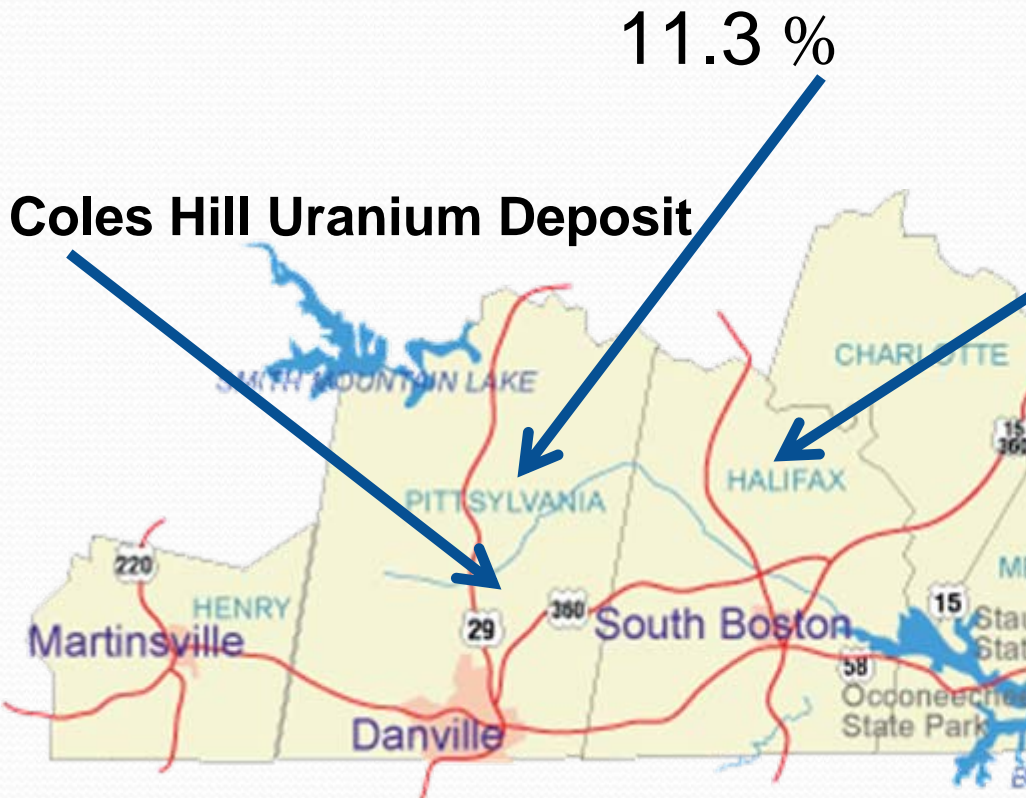

Area Unemployment---Today



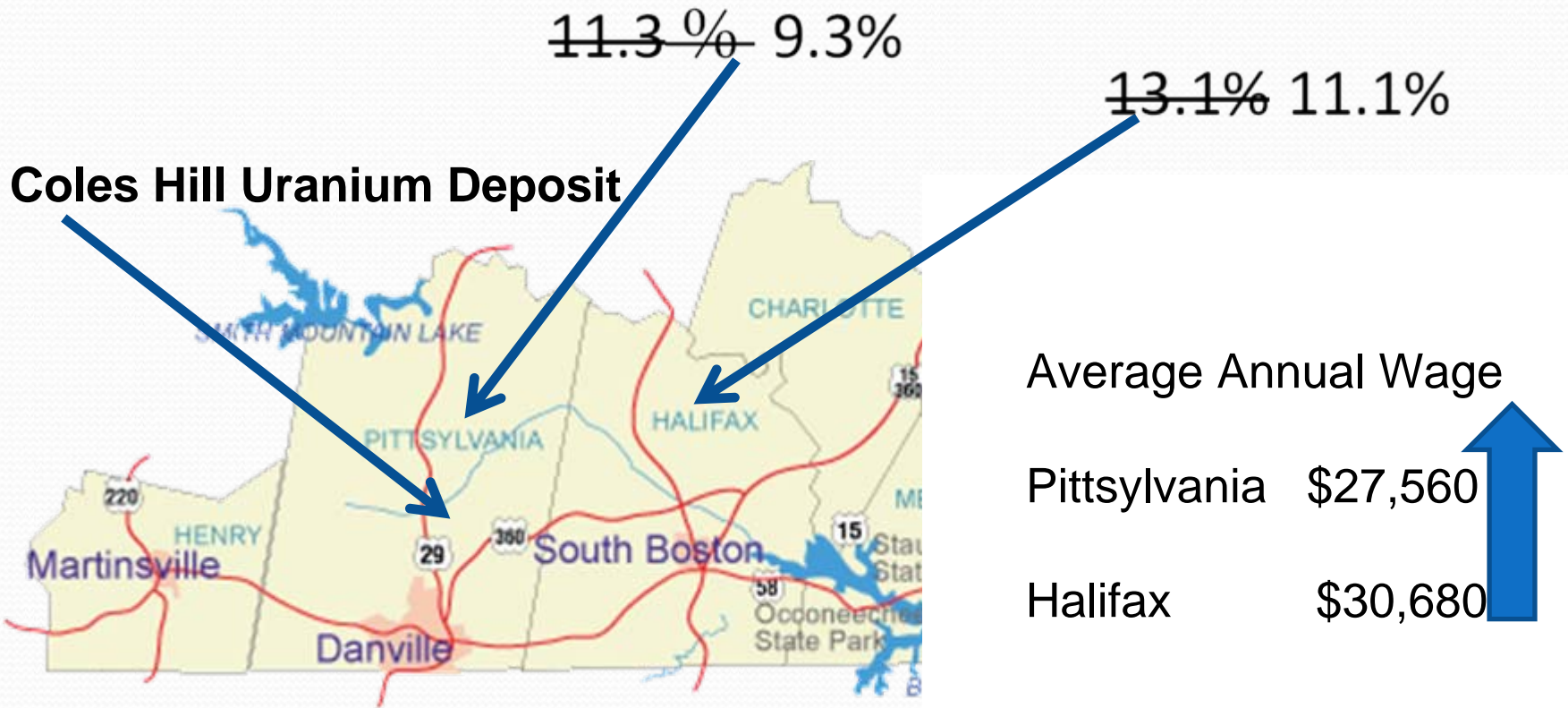
Average Annual Wage

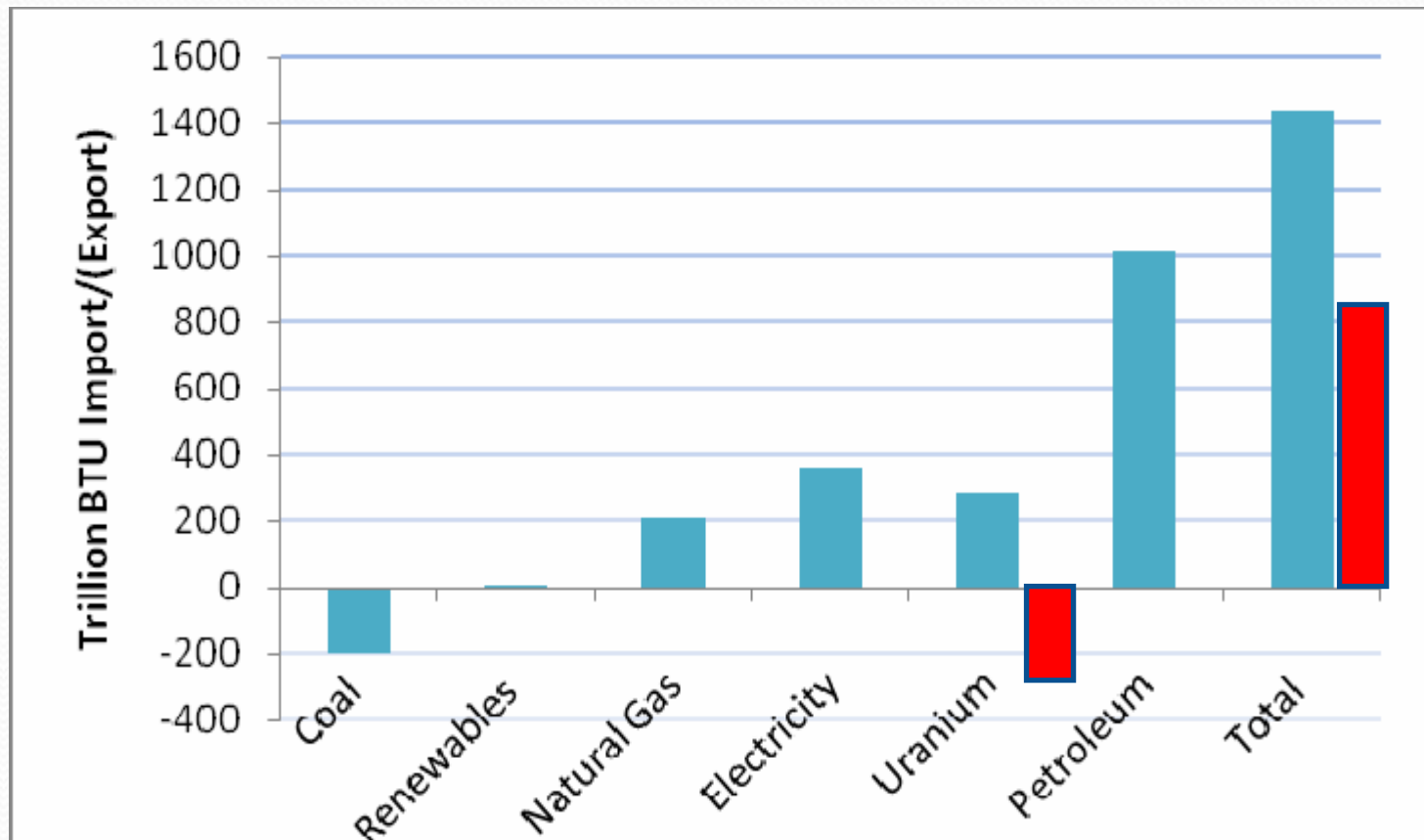
